

# EUREF 2016 Resolutions

## Resolution No. 1.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

*noting* the efforts of the EUREF Multi GNSS Working group, the EPN Central Bureau and the station operators of the EPN network in supplying RINEX3 format data

*and recognising* that the RINEX3 format includes a new file naming convention

*requests* that station managers submitting RINEX3 data use this naming convention as indicated in the EPN guidelines for stations and operational centres

*and urges* the Analysis Centres of the EPN to make use of the available new GNSS data in their operational submissions to the EPN Analysis Combination Centre

## Resolution No. 2.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

*recognising* the importance of having concise and up-to-date EUREF Terms of Reference

*and considering* that the last update of the EUREF Terms of Reference was in 2008

*requests* the EUREF Technical Working Group thoroughly review the existing Terms of Reference and formulate a revised draft in time for the EUREF 2017 symposium

## Resolution No. 3.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

*considering* the link between the International Terrestrial Reference System (ITRS) and the European Terrestrial Reference System 1989 (ETRS89)

*and noting* the improved accuracy and stability of the origin and scale of the recent ITRS realisation ITRF2014

*and further considering* the significance of the possibilities for an updated ETRS89 realisation based on the ITRF2014

*and regarding* the EUREF Technical Working Group intention to issue a questionnaire asking for opinions of the EUREF members on this important subject

*urges* the EUREF community to make every effort to answer the questionnaire in detail and feed their requirements for the ETRS89 realisation back to the Technical Working Group
